 - Must be 16 years old by the orientation date (May 22nd).
 - Completed EICC application (www.eicc.edu/apply) (if you have never taken college classes with us before).
 - Completed summer concurrent registration form. <u>CCIR Registration Form</u>
 - Completed background check form. <u>Background Check Form</u>
 - \$25 background check fee cash only (no checks accepted)
 - Copy of ID this can be a driver's license, state issued ID, or school ID with picture.
- After registration, you will need to attend the mandatory CNA meeting. MCC's meeting will be held at the MCC
 Campus on May 22nd, 4-5pm. You must attend the mandatory meeting to be eligible for the class. If you do not
 attend, you will be removed from the class, and a student from the waitlist will be enrolled.
