- Vehicle Registration Form for a Parking Tag: If you are driving to school and do not have an MHS Parking Tag, you will need to complete a Vehicle Registration Form. This parking tag will be used until the Class of 2025 graduates. Completed forms should be returned to the Student Services office. Students with an MHS Parking Tag can park in the Bonnie or Cedar Street parking lots.
